

Dalgarno part of history with Sask Lacrosse

Provincial team medals for first time at U-16 national field championships, claiming bronze

The Saskatchewan U-16 Field Lacrosse team did something they had never done before over the Labour Day weekend in Saskatoon as they medalled in the National Field Lacrosse Alumni Cup.

Moose Javian Chance Dalgarno was part of that team and he said the accomplishment is an impressive one considering they were up against some

larger and tough programs from Ontario, British Columbia and others.

"It's pretty amazing that we could actually do that with the size of our team and the amount of people we had," said Dalgarno. "We were really good. We had a good strong team connection, we had some amazing shooters."

Team Sask beat Alberta in the bronze medal game 17-10. Dalgarno, who plays the midfield position

and is usually busy setting up goals, scored his only goal of the tournament in the game.

In five games, he set up three others for four points in the tournament.

"I think I did pretty good throughout it," said Dalgarno.

Team Sask is built from the Saskatoon Stingers U-16 rep team, so having the tournament held on their own turf in their own city certainly had helped. It wasn't too far of a drive for Dalgarno's friends and

family either.

"There were a lot more friends and family to support us there," said Dalgarno.

To get to the bronze medal game, Team Sask won their first two games, lost their next two but still qualified for the bronze medal game.

After a blowout win over Manitoba to kick off the tournament, Team Sask beat Alberta 14-9 before losing to the eventual silver medalists from British Columbia 16-9 and

gold medalists Ontario 25-2.

In the U-19 division, the top three finishes were the exact same as Ontario won gold, B.C. took silver and Saskatchewan added another bronze to their trophy case.

The U-19 club also had with a third place finish at for the First Nation's Trophy, which took place at the same time as the Alumni Cup.
